

**Bank of America and the Missouri Council on Economic Education  
Personal Finance Online Professional Development Opportunity**

Are you responsible for teaching your high school’s Personal Finance course? e-Learning for Educators now offers an online professional development course to assist you in finding the resources you need to effectively teach Personal Finance. The short 8-week course is completely online and does not require travel to any physical location to complete the workshop. This 7 week Personal Finance course developed in partnership with the Missouri Council on Economic Education provides opportunities to explore online resources, develop and critique personal finance lessons using the backward design model, and network with personal finance teachers across the state.

Teachers responsible for teaching the required high school Personal Finance course in the counties and districts listed below are eligible for a special program sponsored by a grant from the Bank of America Foundation. Eligible districts are those that are in a Bank of America “service area” and have a student population with 51% or higher Free and Reduced Lunch Program (FRLP) participation. The special program provides selected teachers with a scholarship to cover course registration fees and a \$100 stipend upon satisfactory completion of the course.
